RE: Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program (LOTCIP) Solicitation 2020

SCCCOG is pleased to announce the third solicitation for the Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program (LOTCIP). This State funding program was established by the Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) to replace locally solicited projects utilizing STP-Urban funding.

Eligible projects include reconstruction and rehabilitation of roads functionally classified as urban collector or higher, bridges meeting the federal definition under 23CFR650.305, and stand-alone sidewalk projects. LOTCIP requires municipalities to fund 100% of design costs; the State funds 100% of construction costs. Eligible projects have an estimated cost of \$300,000 or more. Please refer to CTDOT's road functional classification map for your town to determine if your proposal is eligible. https://portal.ct.gov/DOT/PP_SysInfo/Functional-Classification-Maps.

SCCOG currently has available \$8,000,000 in LOTCIP funding, allocated by the State Bond Commission, and we anticipate that the LOTCIP program will continue to be funded in future years. Our current annual allocation is \$5,000,000 per year.

SCCOG member municipalities are invited to provide one or more LOTCIP pre-applications to krattan@seccog.org no later than 2:00 p.m. Friday, March 18th. In an effort to ensure that our municipalities have assurance of funds prior to significant local expenditure, we request a digital pre-application submission consisting of:

- A sketch plan, including project location, and existing and proposed cross sections
- A completed CTDOT cost estimation form (see CTDOT LOTCIP Guidelines)
- A one page program description including: project purpose and need; specifying rehabilitation or reconstruction project; project limits; anticipated permits; rightof-way acquisitions; drainage and utility impacts; and anticipated length of design in months.

April 7 SCCOG Executive Committee Prioritization and Endorsement
